MESSAGE

**THIRTY-EIGHTH SAARC CHARTER DAY
(08 December 2022)**

On the occasion of the Thirty-eighth Charter Day of the South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC), I extend warmest felicitations to the respected Heads of State and Government, the peoples and the Governments of the Member States.

At the First SAARC Summit in Dhaka, the South Asian Heads of State or Government launched SAARC by endorsing its Charter on 08 December 1985. Since then, the Member States, SAARC Secretariat, Specialized Bodies and Regional Centres have been commemorating the Charter Day as a mark of respect to the visionary Leaders, who founded SAARC. The commemoration is also aimed at promoting awareness about SAARC and enhancing South Asian identity and solidarity within the region and beyond.
